Making exchanges happen

The association is therefore looking for decommissioned fire trucks, ambulances and equipment which can save lives not so far from you.

We believe strongly that passing on know-how along with the equipment is the only way to ensure the recipient can use the equipment safely and efficiently in case of an emergency.

During such training sessions both parties usually discover new practices which can be used back home - such as efficient wildfire tactics learnt in Greece, Cyprus and Portugal.
